Recording the Soul

For this project, students will design a record cover that represents their soul. It can be something you are feeling, something you value, or a recreation of an album cover that you really enjoy. Part 1: Designing your record

- ➤ Brainstorm what is really important to you and how you can represent that with an album cover to your life
- > Sketch your idea
- > Get it ok'd by Sav

Part 2: Working with acrylic paint

- ➤ Practice in small sections on a scrap paper:
 - Blending 2-5 colours (play around with how much colour you put in to produce different effect)
 - Layering 1-2 times
 - Gradient 1

Part 3: Complete the record to your soul

> Begin **lightly** drawing the final copy

- ➤ Carefully paint your record
